SECTION 4: First aid measures

4.1. DESCRIPTION OF FIRST AID MEASURES

- SKIN CONTACT:** Rinse with water thoroughly. In the case of skin irritation or allergic reactions see a physician.

SECTION 5: Firefighting measures

5.1. EXTINGUISHING MEDIA:

Suitable extinguishing media: Use chemical foam, dry powder, carbon dioxide or water fog.
